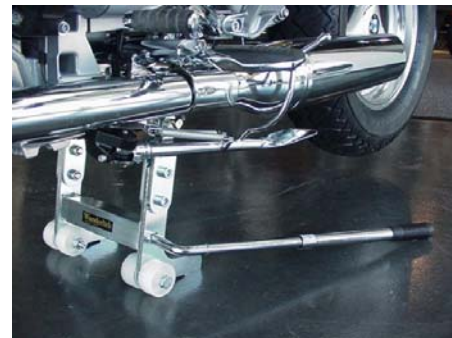




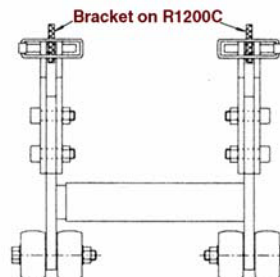
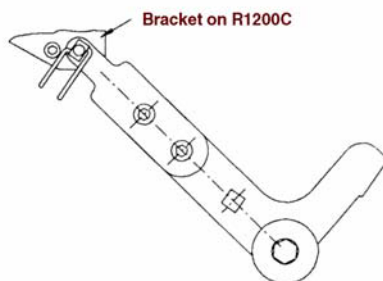
## Cruiser – Lifter Instructions for use



### Wunderlich

Congratulations on your wise decision to purchase a **Wunderlich** Cruiser – Lifter. Please follow these brief instructions so that you may begin enjoying your Lifter right away!

- Loosen the wing nut on the stand and remove the two pins.
- With your bike resting on the side stand, position the Cruiser – Lifter under the bike, with the wheels on the ground, to the rear of the bike.
- Line up the holes in the stand with the holes in the bracket, located below the foot pegs of your R1200C. Push the pins through the holes and snap the retaining clips around the stand for safety.
- Tighten the wing nut.
- Extend the telescoping lever to the stand on either the left or right side, with the handle pointing towards the rear of the bike.
- Lift the bike upright, so that both wheels of the Lifter are touching the ground.
- Simultaneously push down on the lever while lifting the motorcycle and the bike will roll back onto the stand. You can push the lever down with one foot while lifting. It is preferable to have someone help you while placing your R1200C on the Lifter.
- When taking the bike off the stand, follow the above directions, in reverse.



### Please Note:

- To make it getting the bike on and off the stand easier, you can place a piece of plywood or similar under the front or rear wheel.
- Check the tightness and correctness of the mounting hardware before each use.
- Do not sit on the motorcycle while it is on the Cruiser – Lifter.
- Do not attempt to roll the bike or move it while placed on the Cruiser – Lifter. The lifter could fold , causing the motorcycle to fall.
